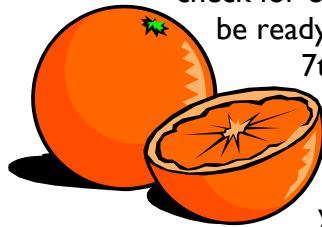

- ♦ **4-H Fruit Sale** - The order forms are due to Mrs. Krebs by Thursday, November 10th, at our general meeting. Please make one large check payable to **Thompson Irish Settlers**. The checks need to be turned in with your completed order form. One large check from the seller for the entire order is much easier. Our club needs to write one large check for our club's entire order. The fruit will



be ready for pick up on Friday, December 7th at the Erin Town Hall after 6:00 pm. It is very important to pick up your fruit in a timely manner or make arrangements with Mrs. Krebs if you are unable to pick it up on the 7th.
