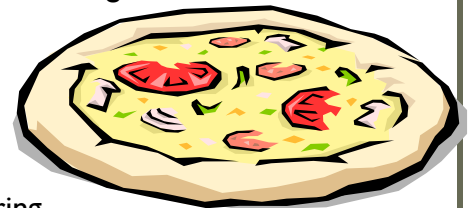

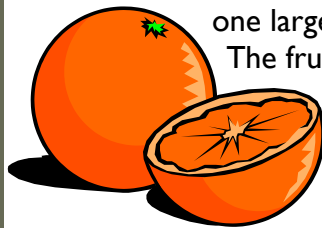
**What's Happening!**

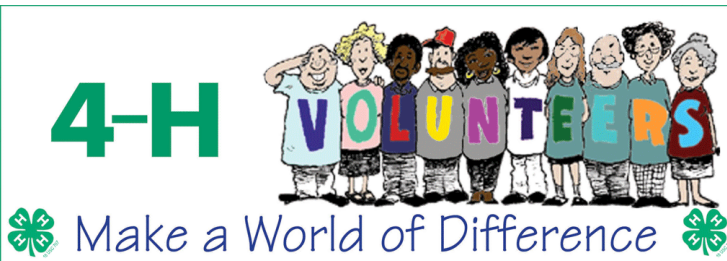
